To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, in Parliament assembled :

The humble petition of the undersigned sheweth :—

That your petitioners are desirous of incorporating a company for the purpose of the transmission, supply and sale of power, light and heat, and of construction and operation of telephone lines, for the transmission of messages for hire, within the Electoral Districts of Esquimalt, Victoria City, North and South Victoria, together with the power of expropriation and appropriation of any lands or waters convenient therefor, and such other powers, rights and privileges as may be necessary, incidental and conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

Your petitioners, therefore, pray that your Honourable Body may be pleased to pass an Act granting to your petitioners the above powers.

And your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
