To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislature of the Province of British Columbia, in Parliament assembled.

The petition of the undersigned male British subjects, of the full age of twenty-one years, resident in the Town of Phœnix, in the County of Yale, and Province of British Columbia, humbly sheweth:—

1. That a petition has been presented to your Honourable Body by the majority in number and value of the assessed owners of certain lands described in said petition and included in what is known as the Town of Phœnix, praying your Honourable Body to incorporate the said lands into a City Municipality to be known as “The Corporation of the City of Phœnix.”

And whereas it is in the interests of the land-owners and people of Phœnix that the prayer of the said petition should be granted.

Now, therefore, your petitioners humbly pray that your Honourable Body will be pleased to pass an Act enabling the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, forthwith, by letters patent under the Public Seal, to incorporate the said lands into a City without requiring the inhabitants of the said lands to observe the provisions of the “Municipalities Incorporation Act.”

And your petitioners, as in duty, bound, will ever pray.
