SIR,—I have the honor to return to you herewith, a despatch from His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor of British Columbia, recommending the establishment of a semi-monthly mail between Okanagan and Okanagan Mission, and between Nicola Lake Post Office and the head of Nicola Lake.

The matters referred to by His Honor, have received careful enquiry and consideration, and it is found that while the correspondence of the Districts for which increased Postal accommodation is desired is extremely trifling, the cost of granting the accommodation would be very heavy. The Postmaster-General directs me therefore to express his regret that he does not feel it at present in his power to carry the suggestion of His Honor into effect.
