PETITION.

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of British Columbia:

In the matter of the "Cariboo Railway Company's Consolidated Act, 1894."

The humble petition of the Cariboo Railway Company sheweth:—

Whereas, by the "Cariboo Railway Company's Consolidated Act, 1894," it was enacted (inter alia) that the Company's railway should be commenced within three years and completed within seven years from the passing of the said Act; and whereas, the said Company desire that the period within which the said railway shall be commenced be extended for a period of four years, and that the period for the completion of the said railway shall be extended for a period of four years.

Your petitioner, therefore, humbly prays that your Honourable House will, at the present Session, be pleased to pass an Act amending Section 29 of the "Cariboo Railway Company's Consolidated Act, 1894," by altering the word "three" in the first line of the said section to the word "seven," and the word "seven" in the second line of the said section to the word "eleven."
