To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, in Parliament assembled :

The petition of John Irving, of the City of Victoria, B. C., Master Mariner ; Stephen O'Brien, of the City of Victoria, Gentleman ; and John H. Brownlee, of the City of Victoria, Broker, humbly sheweth :—
