PETITION.

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, in Parliament assembled:

The petition of the Chilliwhack Railway Company, humbly sheweth:-

That the said company was, by an Act of your Honourable House, incorporated in 1891 for the purpose of constructing a railway from a point on the Mission branch of the Canadian Pacific Railway to a point in the Municipality of Chilliwhack.

That the railway authorized to be constructed was to be begun within two years and completed within three years after the passing of the said Act.

That your petitioners have been unable to begin the work of construction within the time limited.

Your petitioners, therefore, pray that your Honourable House will be pleased to pass an Act amending your petitioners' Act of Incorporation, and extending the time for the comencement of the work of completion for a further period of two years.
