
PETITION.

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, in Parliament assembled:

The humble petition of the Noble Five Consolidated Mining and Milling Company (Foreign), which has its head office at the Town of Sandon, in the District of West Kootenay, sheweth:—

That your petitioners are desirous of having an Act passed by your Honourable Body, granting them the right to appropriate five hundred inches of the waters of Cody Creek, in the Slocan Mining Division of West Kootenay District, with power to erect flumes for the purpose of operating a concentrator, electric light plant, power drills, and all other purposes usually necessary or incidental to the mining or milling of ore; and also with power to your petitioners of expropriating land for such purposes.
