PETITION.

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Provincial Legislature now in session :

1. That whereas a large section of Southern British Columbia, known as the Similkameen and Nicola Districts, rich in coal, mineral and agricultural resources, is at present hampered in development by want of adequate transportation facilities ; and

2. Whereas the Legislature of British Columbia, now in session, have under advisement certain measures to grant assistance to a railroad or railroads through these important districts ;
