To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, in Parliament assembled:

The petition of the undersigned, the Pacific Northern and Omineca Railway Company, of the City of Victoria, in the Province of British Columbia, humbly sheweth:—

That your petitioners are desirous of amending their Act of Incorporation, being 64 Victoria, chapter 50, of the Statutes of the said Province, as amended by the "Pacific Northern and Omineca Railway Act Amendment Act, 1902," being 2 Edward VII., chapter 77, by extending the time for the commencement of the construction of the Company's line of railway and for the expenditure of 10 % of the capital and for the completion of the said railway, as limited by sub-section (5) of section 44 of the British Columbia Railway Act, and by increasing the capital of the said Company.

Wherefore your petitioners humbly pray that your Honourable House may be pleased to pass an Act for the purposes above mentioned.

And, as in duty bound, your petitioners will ever pray.
