To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia:

The petition of the undersigned humbly sheweth:—

That your petitioners are desirous of incorporating a company with power to build, construct, equip, maintain and operate a line of railway of standard gauge, to be operated by steam, electricity or other power, for the carrying of freight, passengers and express:—Commencing at a point at or near Lena Island, Skidegate Inlet, Queen Charlotte Islands; thence following the valley of the Honna River in a northerly direction by the most feasible route to Camp Robertson; thence to Camp Wilson; thence to a point at or near Shields Island, Rennell Sound, and from any point on the said railway to any point on Masset Inlet, with power to construct and operate branch lines not exceeding twelve miles in length; to construct and operate telegraph and telephone lines for the purpose of its business and for the public; and with power to own, use and operate water-powers convenient to the road for railway and other purposes; and with all the powers given by the Model Railway Bill; and with such other powers and privileges as are usually given to railway companies.

Your petitioners, therefore, pray that your Honourable Body may be pleased to pass an Act granting to your petitioners the above powers.

And your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
