

PETITION.



*To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislature of British Columbia,
in Parliament Assembled :*

The Petition of the undersigned, the Nanaimo Electric Light, Power and Heat Company, Limited, humbly sheweth :—

1. That your petitioners are a Joint Stock Company carrying on the business of an electric lighting, heating and power company at the City of Nanaimo, and are desirous of obtaining an Act empowering your petitioners to extend the electric system now established by them at the City of Nanaimo, and to erect and maintain an electric system for the purpose of supplying electricity for light and heat and power to persons, mines and places within the limits of the said city, and also within a radius of fifteen (15) miles therefrom, and to do all things necessary and usual for carrying on said electric system.

Wherefore your petitioners humbly pray that Your Honourable Body will be pleased to pass an Act extending the objects for which your petitioners were incorporated as aforesaid, and conferring upon them all necessary powers in that behalf.

And your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
