To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, in Parliament assembled:

The humble petition of the City of Vancouver sheweth:—

That your petitioners are desirous of an Act being passed to amend the “False Creek Foreshore Act, 1904, by amending sections 8 and 13 of said Act by extending the time within which the City of Vancouver may exercise the right of expropriation of the lands, etc., required for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Act to the first day of January, 1910, and by relieving the City of Vancouver from proceeding forthwith with the work of reclamation in the event of its exercising the right of expropriation and for such other powers and authorities as may be requisite or necessary in the premises.

Your petitioners, therefore, humbly pray that your Honourable Body may be pleased to pass an Act amending the said Act as above mentioned.

And your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray, etc.
