# PETITION.

*To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the  
Province of British Columbia, in Parliament assembled:*

The petition of the Reeves' Association of British Columbia, humbly sheweth:—

That the Reeves of the Rural Municipalities of the Lower Mainland have formed themselves into an association for mutual benefit and to obtain greater uniformity in municipal affairs, also to suggest needed amendments to the Municipal and other Acts bearing on municipal matters, which practical experience has shown to be for the public good.

That in the opinion of your petitioners the amendment to the "Land Registry Act," as now before your Honourable Body, entails needless delay and expense, inasmuch as it requires a second service (on the persons interested) by the Registrar, before a tax sale deed can be registered.

Your petitioners, therefore, pray that your Honourable House will be pleased at the present session to amend the Act so as to render unnecessary this second service.

And your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
