The Petition of Thomas Paterson, Manager of Cape Beale Light-house, Cape Beale, in the Province of British Columbia, humbly sheweth :

That your petitioner is desirous of incorporating a Company, with power to supply power, light and heat for mining, lighting, domestic, manufacturing and other purposes to the inhabitants, corporations, mines, mills and manufactories situate within a radius of twelve miles of the town of Alberni, Vancouver Island, and also to manufacture, supply, transmit and distribute power, light, heat and electricity within the said radius, and also to construct, equip, operate and maintain tramways, railways and telephone systems within the said radius, and to extend the said systems to other districts contiguous thereto, and to erect, construct and maintain all such works, bridges, tracks, roads, sub-ways, buildings, tanks, flumes, dams, race-ways, poles, pipes, wires, cables, structures and appliances as may be necessary to fully carry out the purposes of the Company, and also to have the right to enter and appropriate lands for power-houses, stations, tramways, lines, pole-lines, and other necessary works, and to appropropriate, use and divert so much of the unrecorded water of any river or creek which may be found convenient or advantageous within or near the said radius as may be necessary for the purposes of the Company, and to do all such things as are incidental or conducive to carrying out of the above objects or any of them.

Your petitioner, therefore, humbly prays that your honourable body may be pleased to pass an Act accordingly, and, as in duty bound, your petitioner will ever pray.
