PETITION.

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, in Parliament assembled:

The humble petition of the undersigned owners and lease-holders of property in the Municipality of Chilliwhack likely to be affected by a proposed scheme for dyking the Sumas, sheweth:—

That the diverting of the waters of the Vedder Creek into either the Atchelitz, Lucka-Kuck or the Chilliwhack would do very serious injury to our farms, and that the damage by flood and seepage would amount to hundreds of thousands of dollars, and that it would be unjust to do such serious damage to a well improved and productive District for a possible advantage to an unimproved one.

And your petitioners further sheweth that the Sumas can be dyked in two sections without so diverting the waters of the Vedder Creek, and by so doing the lands of your petitioners would in no way be damaged.
