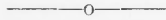


PETITION

TO BRING IN AN ACT INTITULED "AN ACT TO AMEND THE BURRARD
INLET RAILWAY AND FERRY COMPANY INCOR-
PORATION ACT, 1891."



*To the Honourable Legislative Assembly of the Province of British
Columbia, in Parliament Assembled :*

The humble petition of the Burrard Inlet Railway and Ferry Company, a body corporate, having its head office in the City of Vancouver, humbly sheweth:—

1. That your petitioners were incorporated under an Act of your Honourable Body intituled the "Burrard Inlet Railway and Ferry Company's Incorporation Act, 1891."

2. That under the said Act your petitioners were given certain powers for the construction and operation of steam or electric railway or telegraph lines from and to and between certain points.

3. That under section 15 of the said Act your petitioners were empowered to construct the said railway in sections, and the time limited for the completion of the first section between Seymour and Capilano Creeks, was within four years from the passage of the said Act.

4. That your petitioners find themselves unable to complete the work of said section within the said time.

Therefore your petitioners humbly pray that the time for the completion of the said section between Seymour and Capilano Creeks be extended for a further period of five years.

And your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray, &c.
