## PETITION.

To the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia:

The humble petition of the Honourable Amor DeCosmos, of the City of Victoria, and Province of British Columbia, sheweth as follows:—

- 1. That your petitioner is the owner of real estate of considerable value within the limits of the City of Victoria, and has paid all taxes levied upon his property by virtue of the "Real Estate Assessment Roll for 1892."
- 2. That your petitioner objects to the passage of an Act to incorporate the Mount Tolmie Park and Cordova Bay Railway Company, on the ground, amongst others, that your petitioner is apprehensive that the granting of the charter therein applied for, will be injurious to his interests as an owner of real estate.
- 3. That your petitioner was unable to discover any plan produced by the promoters in support of the petition for the said Act, and your petitioner believes that the said promoters, have either no defined or proposed line of railway, or have purposely suppressed the plan (if any).

Your petitioner therefore prays that your Honourable Body will be pleased not to sanction the passage of the said Act.

And your petitioner, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
