To the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of British Columbia :

The petition of the undersigned Granby Consolidated Mining, Smelting and Power Company, Limited, humbly sheweth :—

1. That your petitioners are incorporated under the “Granby Consolidated Mining, Smelting and Power Company Act, 1901.”

2. That your petitioners are desirous of obtaining amendments of the said Act, in manner following, that is to say :—

To change the division of the authorised capital of the Company from one million five hundred thousand shares of the par value of \$10.00 per share, to one hundred and fifty thousand shares of the par value of \$100.00 per share ; and to empower the directors of the Company to declare dividends without reference to the shareholders.

And your petitioners pray for leave to introduce a Bill accordingly.
