## PETITION.

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia:

Your petitioners, who are residents of the district between Osoyoos and Rock Creek, in British Columbia, humbly sheweth:—

Whereas a Bill entitled "An Act for the Redistribution of British Columbia into Electoral Districts and to amend the 'Provincial Elections Act,'" has lately been introduced by the Hon. Attorney-General; and

Whereas in said Bill a gross injustice has been done, or attempted to be done, by the unfair and unnatural manner in which the East Riding of Yale is divided up; and

Whereas such contemplated division of the East Riding of Yale is contrary to natural boundaries and is against the wishes of every resident of the district irrespective of party.

Therefore your petitioners humbly pray that for the benefit of the Province at large, and this section in particular, your Honourable Body will cause said Bill to be amended so that the division of the East Riding of Yale be a line drawn east and west from Penticton; thence to the International Boundary, and to include the Smilkameen, Osoyoos, Anarchist Mountain, Camp McKinney, Rock Creek, Midway, Boundary Falls, Anaconda, Greenwood and Grand Forks.
