# PETITION

TO AMEND THE "NORTH VANCOUVER ELECTRIC COMPANY'S INCORPORATION ACT, 1892."

*To the Honourable Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, in Parliament assembled :*

The humble petition of the North Vancouver Electric Company, a body corporate, having its head office in the City of Vancouver, humbly sheweth :—

1. That your petitioner is a body corporate, being incorporated by the "North Vancouver Electric Company's Incorporation Act, 1892."

2. That by section 40 of said Act it is provided that your petitioner shall commence their works within one year, and shall so far complete the same as to be able to supply electricity and power to other corporations, companies, and persons within three years of the passage of said Act.

3. That your petitioners have commenced their said work within one year from the passage of the said Act, as therein provided, and have spent certain large sums of money in so doing, but find that they are unable to complete the same so as to be able to supply electricity and power to other corporations, companies, and persons within three years from the passage of said Act.

Wherefore, your petitioners humbly pray that their Act of Incorporation may be amended by extending for a further period of three years the time limited in the said Act for the completion, so far as to be able to supply electricity and power to other corporations, companies, and persons, of the works of the said Company.

And your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray, &c.
