To the Honorable W. J. Armstrong, Minister of Finance and Agriculture, British Columbia.

SIR,—I have the honour to submit below a Comparative Statement of the Estimated and Actual Revenue for the year ending 31st December, 1873.

The figures representing the Actual Revenue have been compiled from Returns furnished to this Department up to the 8th instant, and a careful estimate of the Revenue that may be expected from those Districts and for those periods of which no accounts have as yet been received, viz. :--

New Westminster, December;

Kootenay, September to December; Cariboo, November and December;

Yale, December;

Kamloops, November and December ;

which accounts, when rendered, will probably shew the estimate above mentioned to be by no means exaggerated.

The excess of Subsidy over the estimate is owing to the increased amount allowed to this Province, in consequence of the readjustment of the Public Debt of the Dominion, since the 30th of June last.

A considerable falling off is apparent in both classes of Mining Revenue, which has occurred for by far the most part in the Districts of Omineca and Cariboo, owing to the number of persons engaged in mining pursuits in those Districts being less than in former years. In "Free Miners' Certificates" alone, Omineca shews a decrease of Revenue of \$1,000, and Cariboo of \$600, while "Mining Receipts General," which have produced less than the "Certificates" since the alteration of the Gold Mining Laws during the Session of 1871-2, fall further short of the Estimates in about the same proportion.

Under the head of Licences is included an amount of over \$5,000, arrears due in Victoria City and District, not collected until the early part of the current year, which will reduce the amount proper for 1873 to about \$23,000.

No repayment for Keep of Prisoners during the year 1873, has been received from the Dominion Government, otherwise "Reimbursements in aid" would probably have exceeded the Estimate by \$3,000. Arrears on this account are still outstanding, the payment made having only covered the amount claimed up to 30th September, 1872.

"Marriage Licence Fees" being now retained, in most cases, by the Registrars, a small amount only has been received by the Government under this head.

The "Wild Land Tax" falls, as will be seen, about seventy per cent. below the Estimate.

The Total Revenue (\$356,951 28) exceeds the Estimated Amount (\$335,300) by \$21,651 28, the difference being mainly due to the increased Subsidy, and to the amounts transferred from the Crown Fund and from the Commissioners of Savings Banks.

The items of "Land Revenue" and "Fines, Forfeitures, and Fees of Court" both considerably exceed the Estimate, but the amount of Revenue is hardly more than equal to the average of the two preceding years (1871 and 1872).
