PETITION.

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, in Parliament assembled:

The humble petition of the "Howe Sound, Pemberton Valley, and Northern Railway Company" sheweth:—

1. That your petitioner is desirous of amending its Act of Incorporation, being the "Howe Sound, Pemberton Valley and Northern Railway Company Act, 1907," by increasing its capital stock to two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000); by increasing its bonding powers from twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) per mile; by connecting the terminus of the line at Newport, at the head of Howe Sound, with the City of Vancouver and any intermediate point or points by telegraph or telephone, or both, and by extending the northern terminus of the line from Anderson Lake to the Town of Lillooet, and with such other powers and privileges usual or incidental to all or any of the aforesaid purposes.

Your petitioner, therefore, prays that your Honourable Body may be pleased to pass an Act amending its said Act of Incorporation and granting it the above powers.

And your petitioner, as in duty bound, will ever pray, etc.
