REPORTS OF SELECT COMMITTEES.

FIRST REPORT

OF THE

SELECT STANDING COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC ACCOUNTS.

Mr. Speaker:—

Your Committee appointed to examine and report upon Public Accounts, beg leave to report as follows:—

That the amount received from the Dominion Government for the Dry Dock at Esquimalt; 47 Vic. chap. 14, was expended prior to the 31st December, 1885, and the sum of \$140,808.33 received by over-draft from the Bank of British Columbia was expended in addition to the revenue received from July to 31st December, 1885. That the Finance Minister is of opinion that the over-draft cannot be repaid to the bank out of the revenue for the year, in addition to meeting all the requirements of the Government for the current year.

That the sums voted for roads, streets and bridges for the fiscal year ending 30th June, 1886, have in some districts been already exceeded.

That the expenditure for the Administration of Justice (other than salaries), was about \$38,000 to date.

That the Act passed in the 47 Vic., chap. 14, provides that the money received by the Government of British Columbia from the lands on Vancouver Island, that are set apart for the railway from Esquimalt to Nanaimo, shall be paid as received into the Bank of British Columbia to the credit of the Receiver-General of Canada.

That this course has not been adopted, as your Committee are informed a different arrangement has been made between Mr. Dunsmuir, acting on behalf of the Railway Company, and the Government, as to the expenditure of these moneys.

Your Committee append return of Liquor and Trade Licences issued at Farwell, by Mr. Sproat, to 31st October, 1885; and a return of receipts and expenditures on account of Island Railway lands to 31st December, 1885,
