# PETITION.

*To the Honourable the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, in Parliament assembled:*

The petition of Charles George Major, of the City of New Westminster, Robert Taylor Williams, of the City of Victoria, and John Andrew Paterson, of Delta, all of the Province of British Columbia, humbly sheweth:—

That your petitioners believe that it is desirable in the public interest that a line of Railway should be constructed and operated from some point on the Gulf of Georgia situated in the Delta Municipality, in the District of New Westminster, thence by the most feasible route to the City of New Westminster, with power to construct branch lines from some point in Delta Municipality in an easterly direction through the Municipalities of Surrey, Langley, and Matsqui, in the said Province, to a point at or near Abbotsford:

Your petitioners are desirous of constructing such Railway, and therefore your petitioners pray that your Honourable Body will be pleased during the present Session to pass an Act to authorize the construction and operation of the said Railway, and for the incorporation of your petitioners, to be known as the "Delta and New Westminster Railway Company."

And your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
