To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia in Parliament assembled:

The petition of the Pacific Coast Fire Insurance Company, humbly sheweth:

That your petitioners are desirous of obtaining an Act to amend its Act of Incorporation, namely, the "Pacific Coast Fire Insurance Company's Act, 1890," among other things to authorise the Company to change the number and qualification of its Directors; to increase the powers of the Company as to effecting contracts of insurance and as to the territory in which it may transact business, and as to acquiring, mortgaging, disposing and investment of property and funds.
