Now know ye, that for divers causes and considerations, and taking into consideration the ease and convenience of Our loving subjects, We have thought fit, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of the Province of British Columbia, to hereby convoke, and by these presents enjoin you, and each of you, that on Tuesday, the twentieth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, at three o'clock in the afternoon, you meet Us in Our said Legislature or Parliament of Our said Province, at Our City of Victoria, FOR THE DISPATCH OF BUSINESS, to treat, do, act, and conclude upon those things which, in Our Legislature of the Province of British Columbia, by the Common Council of Our said Province may, by the favour of God, be ordained.

In testimony whereof, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of the said Province to be hereunto affixed. Witness, the Honourable Clarence Wallace, Lieutenant-Governor of Our said Province of British Columbia, in Our City of Victoria, in Our said Province, this eighth day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, and in the fifteenth year of Our Reign.
