
REPORT OF SELECT COMMITTEE.

VICTORIA PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

To the Honourable the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly.

The majority of your Select Committee appointed to visit the Public Schools of Victoria beg most respectfully to report :—

That in view of the revenues of the Province not increasing in proportion to the expenditures that are required under the present School system, a tuition fee of \$5 per quarter should be charged each scholar in the High School.

In regard to the different classes in the main building, we found each department under good order and discipline, and the teachers well qualified for the duties devolving upon them. Each room was in tolerable good order and cleanliness.
